

Information on Wellington boots

Congratulations on the purchase of your quality products. Wellington boots are very popular in bad weather such as rain, wet and slush, as your feet are dry and protected from the moment you slip into your boots.

Wellies made from natural rubber offer the best comfort. Natural rubber boots are in large part handmade and thus may show slight irregularities such as small bumps, differences in colour and different gloss which do not compromise the function and do not justify a reason for complaint.

From time to time natural rubber boots show efflorescence in form of whitish-grey spots. This is also a feature of natural rubber.

If you find these spots ugly, you can remove these with suitable natural rubber care products.

A Wellington boot is waterproof and easy to clean.

If the wellies are dirty they can be wiped with a damp cloth or cleaned with water and they will be as beautiful as on the first day.

The sponge or cloth should be of soft quality.

To enjoy your boot for a long time the right care is necessary. The Wellington boot should be sprayed regularly with a care spray.

This is needed to keep the natural rubber supple and prevent hairline cracks from forming

As your natural rubber boots are a nature product it is not recommended to leave your boots in the sun or expose them to extreme temperatures for a long term.

When you aren't wearing your boots it is best to store them in a dark, cool place.

Furthermore our experience has shown that customers sometimes have the feeling that their feet are getting wet, but the Wellington boots usually do not show any signs of leakage. This feeling of dampness often depends on the choice of socks. Pure cotton socks, for example, absorb a lot of moisture but don't release it again which inevitably leads to dampness in the Wellington boot.

On the other hand if good functional socks, such as those from our trekking /sport range, are worn with the Wellington boots, these socks have the advantage of absorbing and passing on the moisture.

This ensures pleasant comfort in your wellies. Being waterproof, Wellington boots obviously have physical limits to their moisture absorption and can only breathe through their lining to a certain extent.

If you pay attention to this small A-Z of Wellington boots you will surely enjoy your boots for longer...
